SECTION 1. Local Law #4-1988, known as the Zoning Law of the Town of Catskill, New York amended in its entirety by Local Law #4-2023, amended Local Law #1-2024 is hereby amended at Article III Section 160-7 thereof to reflect the following change to the zoning map of the Town of Catskill, New York:

The following tax map parcel, identified with this current owner is hereby changed from Industrial to High Density Residential:

- a. Owner's Name: Charles Merritt Jr. and Kathleen Waldron
- b. Property Location: Quarry Hill Road
- c. Tax Map ID #: 212.00-2-5

SECTION 2. This Local Law contains references to only the new, amended or repealed sections of the stated chapter of Town Code. The new and amended section shall supersede all prior inconsistent sections and provisions of these chapters.

SECTION 3. Should any paragraph, section or portion of this Local Law be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unlawful, the same shall not affect the remainder thereof as a whole or any part thereof than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and filing with the Secretary of State.
