Dear Mr. Finch:

We have prepared this letter proposal for our continuation of the required landfill post-closure monitoring and reporting services at the closed Catskill Landfill for the next three-year period (2022-2024). We have been providing post-closure monitoring and reporting services for the Town of Catskill since 1994 after we assisted the Town with the landfill closure.

We have had a successful history of lowering the post-closure monitoring and reporting costs for the Town. In May 2000, we successfully petitioned NYSDEC to reduce the post-closure monitoring frequency of the closed Town Landfill from a quarterly monitoring schedule to a bi-annual monitoring schedule. In February of 2007 Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C. (B&L) submitted another monitoring reduction request to NYSDEC, which was approved and further reduced the monitoring frequency from bi-annual to annual monitoring.

The costs listed below are for our continued involvement on this project. Our services include: data review, laboratory oversight, and technical reporting services, which include reporting of the leachate wastewater treatment plant analyses. The costs below do not include the necessary subcontracted analytical services from Pace Analytical, which are billed to the Town directly.

This proposal does not include any additional engineering services or testing which may be requested by the NYSDEC or necessary as a result of changing site conditions. Although unlikely, should the need arise for any additional B&L services, a separate supplemental cost proposal would be submitted for your review and approval. Again, it is not anticipated that any such additional services will be necessary or requested. Project invoices will be prepared on a percent complete lump sum basis.

If this proposal meets your approval, please authorize below and return one copy of this letter agreement for our records. The receipt of this signed agreement will serve as our notice to proceed with the necessary upcoming services in 2022.
